

RICHARD J BRINGS AWARENESS TO INDIA

ost of the villages in our area of northwest are located India, inside the forest and there are so many mountains all around. There is a strong influence of local extremist organizations. Those extremists take the girls and boys from their homes and force them to go with them. They are forced into prostitution and other types of wrong things. They are taken to the metro cities to be sold. That is why so many parents send their children somewhere (like orphanages) to keep them safe. The traffickers prey on poor communities and lure parents by promising them a job for their children. Due to greed and poverty, parents allow their children to go with those people. Most of the villagers here are illiterate and poor and do not have money.

Recently, a young girl named Seema was saved from child traffickers. By the grace of God Seema was saved by our



local police after two weeks of being captive by traffickers. She was found in Siliguri, a tourist city in West Bengal. She is now staying with one of our pastors, Pastor Peter. Seema, like many young girls, has problems within her family. Her mother has passed away and her father, who is a heavy drinker, married another women who does not want Seema in the house. She became easy prey for the traffickers.

My ministry has an awareness program for the poor and unreached villages. I travel with our church youth to help



them explain to the parents and children what happens to their children when they are taken. We have arranged an anti child trafficking campaign in villages and the village schools. We give them books, handouts, food, and snacks in their school bags. We teach them that they should never go anywhere with anyone. We also give information to the parents about how bad people can do great harm to their children.



We are so encouraged to reach out to the lost people. We have reached 10 more villages, and I am trying to equip more leaders to help. The sewing school that we created to equip the young girls with a skill is going well. They come 3 times a week for training. This livelihood will help pull families out of poverty and prevent children from being taken.

Please pray for my ministry. Please pray for the field where we share the Gospel.

ALBERT AIDS IN PROVIDING SAFE DRINKING

ven though Nigeria is the most populated country in Africa, there are over 70 million people that don't have access to safe drinking water! Despite its growing youthful population and being a leading oil exporting nation, the poverty rate of its citizens is one of the highest in the world. Many families live on less than \$1 a day.

The living conditions in the rural villages are dreadful and the women in those communities are most affected. They are among the extremely poor and face untold hardships due to violent conflicts and the lack of necessities like food, water, clothing, and shelter. They labor many hours farming to produce food and walk long distances to provide water for their families. Girls in these rural



communities are easy targets for human trafficking. As they walk long distances to access water, they are often sexually abused, kidnapped, and sold



into prostitution rings or taken to work in cities as house slaves for the rich. Our church family in Nigeria has started an advocacy program to fight for the rights of women and children. Mobilizing the Christian community, they are creating awareness of the dangers faced by women and girls in rural villages. We are mounting pressure on the authorities to help rescue the girls forcefully taken.

With the help of Heartland International Ministries, we are responding to this basic and fundamental need of providing borehole water wells in urban and rural communities in Nigeria. This year, 11 water wells were dug and/or repaired in villages across seven states in northern Nigeria. This water project has

already provided clean water to more than 27,000 people in over 1,000 households. Water was provided to the Bible Heritage School along with the construction of bathrooms for the boys and the girls. Schools, churches, and widow centers have benefited from the clean water project. Entire communities have been transformed! As the news of our work to bring water to underserved communities spread, other villages and organizations began reaching out to us asking for help to bring water to their communities. With our current funding, we will be able to provide 9 additional wells and boreholes, but more is needed.

H.I.M. is poised to make a significant impact in the lives of thousands by providing safe

drinking water across Nigeria. Our goal is to improve the quality of life and share the love of Jesus through our water well and livelihood projects. We hope to raise money for additional water projects and livelihood/ training programs for women. Helping women learn a skill or start a business will provide them the opportunity to rise above poverty.



SURENDRA FIGHTS HUMAN TRAFFICKING

of began my journey fighting human trafficking after hearing many stories from a Christian friend of mine working in Mumbai, India as a rescue worker. He would always share with me the graphic details of the miserable plight of the girls in the brothels out there and I would be greatly moved. Most of these girls were trafficked into Mumbai, the biggest redlight zone of India, Nepal, and Bangladesh. Since Nepalese girls are naive and gullible, they often fall prey to the traffickers who promise them lucrative job offers in India. Sometimes, these unfortunate girls are even married by the traffickers to be sold into

prostitution. To force these girls into prostitution, they go through untold torture such as gang rape, starvation, brutal beatings etc. until they give in. The stories of the gross injustice and evil perpetrated to these hopeless girls are what inspired me to join Tiny Hands Nepal ten years ago. The organization monitored the India - Nepal borders to intercept the vulnerable girls from being trafficked since India-Nepal is an open border. Any naive girl crossing the border means her world has crumbled. So, intercepting these girls and sending them back home means saving them from the irreparable loss they would end up in. Every month, we would get the success stories of intercepting many girls from 13 and above.

heard many in-depth stories of the girls intercepted. Poverty, lack of education, family problems were some of the top reasons the girls found themselves in the situation. The traffickers would go from village to village looking for the poverty-stricken families in which the girls would be burdensome for the parents. The parents in the remote villages consider the girls to be a burden and they are unfairly treated. Taking advantage of this situation, the traffickers allure the parents saying a bright future is awaiting their daughters somewhere. This




IN POVERTY STRICKEN VILLAGES IN NEPAL

the border Т oversaw monitoring work of almost 100 staffers at the India - Nepal border. My responsibility was to visit the borders and encourage, equip, and lead the staff to make them more effective workers. As the years went by, I faced many challenges and hardships including despair and depression at times as the job was extremely overwhelming. There were times when we would receive threat calls from the traffickers. There came a time when I had to take some time off. I prayed to God asking if I should continue in this direction or if there was a different path for me.

Not long after, I received a request to translate the Kingstone Graphic Bible into Nepali Language. This was the beginning of my new direction! I began translating other Christian books into the Nepali language which have impacted many lives. distribute these books to many people in remote villages for free! They are in continual demand. I realized that a book could go where a preacher can't go! The impact is exponential. Praise God! I travel to the villages to encourage the small flocks and speak to the young girls and



parents about the dangers of traffickers. I am also working as a Sunday School teacher in charge of about 80 students. I feel more like a spiritual father to these children.

I have two co-workers, Lucky and Prakash. Lucky shares the Gospel to hundreds of people each week in the streets of Nepal. Prakash is saving people in a health crisis by reaching them and distributing medicine and necessary health supplies to the farflung villages. We have been imagining how we can help save the Nepalese churches from being shut down in the face of growing Hindu hostility against Christians. We have initiated giving them legal counseling on how they can register their churches as a "Religious Trust". This is how the Lord is enabling us to impact the body of Christ we never thought we would be so privileged to do so. All the glory to God alone!

Hallelujah – praise the Lord let's do more in 2024!


